- All graduate students receiving a tuition waiver as part of their graduate assistantship award
- All undergraduate, graduate and ESL international students holding F or J visas
- All graduate students enrolled in programs that require proof of health insurance. Currently these are students enrolled in the BMED and CHBE programs and APPH majors.
- All graduate students receiving fellowships that fully fund their tuition.

International Student Fee

\$25 will be assessed to students who hold an F or J Visa for each term of enrollment.

All tuition charges, fees, board, room rent, or other charges are subject to change at the end of any academic term
