In-State/Out of State Classification

At the time of admission to Georgia Institute of Technology a student will be classified as either a resident or non-resident of the State of Georgia for determining the amount of tuition a student will be assessed. A student will either be assessed the resident (in-state) or non-resident (out-of-state) tuition rate listed above based on this determination.

Policies and Procedures for determining the classification of residency status are set forth by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.

Mandatory Student Fees

Students taking 4 or more hours are required to pay the mandatory fees listed below. Students taking less than 4 hours are required to pay the Transportation Fee, the Technology Fee and the USG Institutional Fee. For the GTREP program, the amount of Mandatory Fees charged will be based upon the campus rates where the student is located plus the USG Institutional Fee (see rates above).
